Mr. Roach and Ms. Pavelka:

Enclosed for your review and records are copies of **Remedial Action Report Addendum - Stormwater Management System Modification**. The report was developed by ARCADIS and approved by this office for submittal.

After the completion of the remediation of Site 34, follow-on inspections identified that a modification was required since the stormwater management system was not performing as expected. I informed you of this in emails including my November 20th email containing the "Stormwater Equivalency Documentation": that document was finalized and resubmitted within a November 23rd email. The work was completed by early December and we are submitting this "as-built" report for the record and/or your approval. The system has worked noticed after the more recent heavy rain.

The issue regarding stormwater quantity requirements brought up in a Ms. Susan Dietrich's December 16th email to me which was responding to my November 20th email is addressed by the calculations in Attachment B. However, we are not seeking approval as the project was completed under CERCLA/Installation Restoration Program; we did not need "to apply for a major revision in accordance with NJAC 7:13-13.3(f)" as suggested in an email from Mr. Gary White that was attached to Ms. Dietrich email.

This document also contains a revised inspection and maintenance checklist (Chapter 4 and Appendix E.) I ask that your review and comment of this section take priority. Any issues brought up from your review, will be addressed by the next contractor.
