The next meeting of the Joint Ordnance Commanders Group (JOCG) Continuous Mixer & Extruder Users Group (CMEUG) will be hosted by Indian Head Division, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Indian Head, Maryland, 20-21 July 2010. The meeting will include technical presentations and a plant tour of Indian Head Division processing facilities. A detailed agenda shall be provided in the near future. 2. This meeting is open, and all presentations must be approved for public release. Meeting proceedings will be released on CD and/or posted to the JOCG CMEUG website at <http://www.pica.army.mil/jocg>. Equipment vendors will be invited to attend and present technical presentations, if appropriate. Approximately 15 high quality technical presentations from academia, government, contractors, the user industry, and equipment vendors are requested. Abstracts must be submitted to Mr. Mark Williams, the Navy Chair of the JOCG CMEUG, by email in MS Word format or by facsimile. Please submit the abstracts as soon as possible, but no later than 21 May 2010. An abstract form as well as a registration form are attached and may also be found on the website. The abstract should be brief and is limited to 250 words.

a. Presentations should be prepared in Powerpoint from MS Office 2000 or newer, and should be submitted electronically by 25 June 2010 to facilitate the release of the meeting proceedings. Presentations will be given from a laptop that will be loaded with all of the presentations. Due to security

restrictions any other supporting data or information that may be used by a presenter brought the day(s) of the conference must be on CD or DVD. USB flash drives/thumbdrives will not be accepted.

3. A continental breakfast and lunch will be offered each day, with a dinner hosted at the Indian Head Division Mix House during the evening of 20 July 2010. A registration fee will be charged to cover the costs of these activities and other meeting expenses. The exact cost is unknown at this point but is expected to be approximately \$150 and can be paid by cash or check only. The final cost, information regarding area hotel reservations, and the meeting agenda will be forwarded to your attention in the near future.
