

On March 16, 2009 Lieutenant General James H. Pillsbury, U.S. Army Materiel Command's Deputy Commanding General visited Picatinny to assess current and future products and technologies in support of the warfighter. The visit included an up-close view of the Self Protection Adaptive Kit (SPARK) and the Rhino briefed by PM CCS PM IED Defeat/Protect Force and the IED Interrogation Arm, HMDS, ANPSS-14 and Vehicle Optic Sensor System presented by PM Countermine & EOD. Additional presentations included Networked Munitions' Spider and Scorpion.
