

PM CCS Supports the 2008 Infantry Warfighting Conference and Modern Day Marine Military Exposition

The 2008 Infantry Warfighting Conference was held September 15-17 at the Iron Works Convention and Trade Center in Columbus, GA. The conference provided a great opportunity to discuss training, Army Force Generation and modularity as the support for the Global War on Terrorism (GWOT) and improving warfighting capabilities continues.

With over 4,500 attendees, presentations from some of the Army's top leadership, breakout sessions and vendor displays from PM CCS, ATK, Textron Defense Systems and BAE Systems, attendees had face-to face opportunities to discuss lessons learned, solutions to problems and find out about product developments and enhancements.

Subject matter experts were on hand to provide in-depth information and demonstrations of the Intelligent Munitions System and the Spider from our Networked Munitions division; the Bunker Defeat Munition and the AT4 -CS from the Shoulder Launched Munitions Division as well as PM CCS' line of non-lethal systems and ammunition.

On the heels of the Infantry Conference, the 28th Annual Modern Day Marine Military Exposition (MDM) was held at the Marines Corps Base in Quantico, VA, September 30 - October 2. MDM showcased products and services from companies such as PM CCS, Gyrocamsystems, and Textron Defense Systems that provide U.S. Marines and expeditionary forces with leading edge war-fighting systems and equipment that are currently in Iraq, Afghanistan and in support of the GWOT.

Similar to the Infantry Conference, subject matter experts were on hand from Networked Munitions for the Spider and Intelligent Munitions Systems as well as experts from the Countermine and EOD Division to highlight products such as the Vehicle Optic Sensor System and the IED Interrogation Arm, both 2007 U.S. Army Greatest Top 10 Inventions.

Together, the efforts of the Army and the Marine Corps made both these events very successful event. In 2009, the Infantry Warfighting Conference will be held September 21 - 24, 2009 and Modern Day Marine will be held September 30 - October 1, 2009, both at the same venue.
