This free program provides educational services to immigrants and other limited English proficient adults to attain the basic skills necessary to function successfully as parents, workers, and citizens.

Using a variety of workbooks, practical materials such as newspapers, forms and applications, and role-play of real life situations, students will develop reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills.

The classes include instruction on the rights and responsibilities of citizenship, naturalization procedures, civic/community participation, and US history and government. Classroom activities will cover English language skills, survival/life skills, workforce/employability skills, family literacy, and citizenship skills.
