Purpose

- The official DA database that reflects the authorized planning population for Army Installations
- ASIP Reports are intended for use by Army planners & programmers as the basis for identifying installation support requirements
- Common Operation Picture (COP) for installation population projections for Army staff planning
- Provide
 - Consistent look at installations
 - Audit trail
- Capture
 - Other tenant activities on installations
 - Contractors
 - Transient and training loads



Populations Types Identified

- **Army Units/Organizations (Authorizations)**
 - Active Army, Army Reserve, Army National Guard
 - MTOE, TDA, and TDA Augmentations to MTOE
- **Army School Load**
 - PCS/TDY (Student Load), BT/OSUT and Reception Loads (Billet Load)
- **Special Army Populations**
 - Non-Additive and RC Full-Time Support (Authorizations)
 - Rotational Loads at Army Training Centers
- **Tenants Other than Army**
 - Contractors, Other Services, DoD Agencies, KATUSA, USACE Civil Works, Commercial Activities (Actuals)
- **Below the Line Numbers**
 - RC Training Loads (Peak Load)
 - Other Surrounding Populations (Actuals)

ASIP Supports



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- Valid Unit Identification Codes (UIC) used to show facility assignments in the Real Property Inventory
- Population used by the Real Property Planning and Analysis System (RPLANS) to generate facility allowance by location
- Stationing and Re-stationing decisions related to Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC), Global Defense Posture Realignment (GDPR), Army Modular Force (AMF) and Grow the Army (GTA) analysis and decision-making
- Basis for calculating family members and school age dependent populations using DoD ratios
- Development and justification of Military Construction Projects
- Provides population to the Installation Status Report- Services for cost pacing measures and performance measures for specific Base Operations Support (BOS) services

POC

- Maintain unit/organization POCs
- Monitor any MTOE/TDA updates
- Monitor all unit/organization population changes (i.e, contractors, tenants, etc.)
- Collect transient and training load information
 - Training provided to other agencies (not currently captured)
- Update/edit ASIP data quarterly on website
- Track changes submitted
- Certify report at end of FY

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ASIP Survey Form for Contractors

- The US Army Installation Management Command (IMCOM) Garrison is conducting a quarterly survey of all units and organizations (both Army and non-Army) that are permanently stationed on the installation.
